CHILD WELFARE DIRECTOR (VOLUNTARY)

Cricket Wales, the new national governing body for junior and senior recreational cricket in Wales will be launched this Spring. The new Board of Directors wishes to appoint a voluntary Child Welfare Director. The role will involve:

- Attending Board meetings to provide leadership expertise within the area of Child Welfare;
